



## **Vacaville High School football team runs wild in 57-8 rout over Armijo, gives coach 100th victory**

Mike Papadopoulos dodged a Gatorade shower after his Vacaville High School football team gave him his 100th victory on Friday night.

The near-miss was about the only miscue the Bulldogs had all night in a 57-8 rout at Armijo.

"I had a pretty close call on the handshake," Papadopoulos said with a laugh. "Seriously, the kids did a wonderful job. They played the way I know we're capable of. We did a lot of things right."

Vacaville improved to 4-3 overall with its third straight victory. The Bulldogs also increased their Monticello Empire League record to 2-0, setting up a showdown for first place in the MEL with Napa next week.

On Friday night, freshman Derriyon Jack was the star, scoring three first-half touchdowns on runs of 31, 23 and 27 yards.

Daniel Wright added a pair of rushing touchdowns. Chris Wood and Isiah Edwards also scored on the ground.

On defense, Jon Donaldson scored on a 35-yard fumble return when he simply swiped the ball from an Armijo running back and headed in the other direction. The Bulldogs also recorded a safety.

Sam Patel added seven extra-point kicks.

Vacaville jumped out to a 14-0 lead after the first quarter, and upped the advantage to 41-0 by halftime.

The Bulldogs led 50-0 after three periods, and 57-0 before Armijo scored in the fourth quarter with a running clock.

"We were pretty happy overall," said Papadopoulos, who improved to 100-29 overall in his 11th season as the Bulldogs' head coach. "We were able to work on some things technically that were important."
