



Vacaville High School football team rallies for 49-45 victory over Enterprise

Vacaville High School's football team staged a furious comeback on Friday night, scoring on a 12-yard run by Daniel Wright with 2:07 left for a 49-45 victory at Enterprise of Redding.

The Bulldogs trailed by as many as 15 points, and were still behind 45-35 with less than four minutes remaining.

Wright scored on a 1-yard run to get within 45-42. The Bulldog defense then held, setting up a 79-yard drive in the final 2:36.

A 24-yard pass play from Troy Claunch to Beau Lopez helped set up Wright's fourth touchdown and the win.

"I'm just very proud of the kids," Vacaville head coach Mike Papadopoulos said. "We had a lot of miscues early on, but we finally caught a couple of breaks in the second half and were able to come back."

Zach Myers added a pair of touchdown catches for Vacaville, one from Claunch and the other from Gabe Caravantes. Brycel Begell also caught a TD pass, as well as a 2-point conversion.

Vacaville took the early lead on a scoring run by Wright, but an interception and a fumble helped Enterprise reel off three straight TDs and take a 22-7 lead early in the second quarter.

Vacaville pulled within 28-20 by halftime. The teams traded scores in the third period before Vacaville outscored the hosts 22-10 over the final 12 minutes.

Vacaville ended the night with 495 yards of offense, rushing for 391 yards. Daniel Wright led the Bulldogs rushing attack with 252 yards on just 16 carries.

The Bulldogs evened their record at 1-1. They host Granite Bay next week.
